

The 2017 – 2018 Annual Meeting will include a ratification vote on proposed changes to the By-Laws.

Summary of Proposed By-Law Changes

The proposed changes to the By-Laws are simply to clean and tighten them up. There were items that needed to be defined more accurately and similar duties combined.

Proposed changes are in the Committees, Liaisons, & Coordinator sections of the By-Laws (Current By-Laws Articles 8 & 9, Proposed By-Laws Articles 8, 9, & 10)

- Social Media/Newsletter/Website Coordinator duties have been combined into the Publicity Committee.
- Artistic Committee is being proposed to be renamed to Production Committee and must have at least 7 members. This change is to reflect that the committee is not only responsible for selecting shows but to also recruit directors & producers. They are not just an artistic committee but must think about the production itself.
- Article 9 Liaison is moved to Article 10 and Article 9 is now titled Coordinators
- Coordinators are separate from Liaisons and this needs to be reflected in the bylaws. Article 9 now defines Coordinators and lists the standing coordinator positions for LTCT.
- Volunteer Coordinator has been removed their duties added to the Membership Coordinator.
- A Front of House Coordinator has been added to the Standing Coordinators
- Article 10 is now Liaisons & defines the Liaisons of the LTCT board.
- The remaining articles are renumbered to reflect proposed changes.
